Anti-gun lawmakers, the media, and Bloomberg funded activists have been demanding a ban on the possession of or future sales of the AR-15 (and the standard 30-round magazines that accompany them) along with hundreds of related firearms simply because of their cosmetic features, despite the fact that this is the most popular firearm in the country and is used for defense against criminals and tyranny every single day. This legislation H.R. 1296/S.66 has hundreds of cosponsors in Congress but has not been voted on at this time.

The state legislature in almost two dozen states have already passed legislation that makes criminals out of law abiding 18-20 year old citizens who buy rifles and shotguns, even though federal law provides for this. Now many are calling for new federal legislation to raise the age of legal gun ownership to 21, across the board. This would make criminals out of citizens who can serve in the military, vote, pay taxes, get married, have careers and enjoy every other aspect of being a legal adult.

Gun control activists have long desired a mandatory 3-day waiting period before law abiding citizens would be able to exercise their 2 nd Amendment freedoms and purchase a firearm for self-defense. 7. In recent years, politicians on both sides of the aisle have tried to advance legislation to radically redefine what gun trafficking is. This redefinition would render the unknowing or negligent gun owner a criminal, on par with career criminals who receive large amounts of money to arm gangs, cartels, and other organized criminal groups, for innocently selling multiple firearms at one time. This would result in otherwise law-abiding citizens being imprisoned for federal gun crimes and being subject to severe penalties.

8. Most mass shootings happen in so-called 'Gun Free Zones,' areas where law-abiding citizens are forced to disarm, which has quite literally resulted in violent criminals targeting these locations. This prevents law-abiding citizens

law abiding parents, teachers, school administrators and others from being able to carry a concealed firearm on school property, resulting in hundreds of murders.
